*Georgia Relay is a FREE public service* that connects people who are deaf, hard of hearing, DeafBlind or speech disabled and use a TTY (text telephone) or other assistive device with standard phone users, relaying the conversation between both parties. The service can be accessed 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and free equipment is available to those who qualify.

Georgia Relay allows for communication between people with hearing or speech disabilities and standard telephone users primarily through use of one of four methods: a traditional Relay (text telephone) call, Internet Relay, CapTel telephone or Video Relay Service (VRS).

Anyone may initiate a Georgia Relay call, simply by dialing 7-1-1.

## 'Angel'ed Eggs (a different take on Deviled Eggs)

### Ingredients:

- 12 eggs
- 1/4 cup ranch dressing
- 6 tablespoons creamy salad dressing (such as Miracle Whip®)
- 2 tablespoons sweet pickle relish
- 1 tablespoon prepared yellow mustard
- 1/4 teaspoon celery seed
- Ground black pepper to taste
- 1/4 teaspoon paprika, for garnish

### Directions:

1. Place eggs into a large saucepan, cover with water, and bring to a boil.
2. Cook for 15 minutes, and cool the eggs under a stream of cold water in the sink, 10 to 15 minutes.
3. Peel the eggs and slice in half lengthwise.
4. Scoop the egg yolks into a bowl, and mash them with a fork.
5. Mix in the ranch dressing, creamy salad dressing, pickle relish, yellow mustard, celery seed, and black pepper until thoroughly combined.
6. Spoon the filling into the egg white halves.
7. Sprinkle each egg half with a pinch of paprika.



A sudoku puzzle is a grid of nine by nine squares or cells, that has been subdivided into nine subgrids or "regions" of three by three cells.

The objective of sudoku is to enter a digit from 1 through 9 in each cell, in such a way that:

•Each horizontal row contains each digit exactly once

•Each vertical column contains each digit exactly once

•Each subgrid or region contains each digit exactly once

Solving a sudoku puzzle does not require knowledge of mathematics; simple logic suffices.

In each sudoku puzzle, several digits have already been entered (the "givens"); these may not be changed.

The puzzler's job is to fill the remainder of the grid with digits -respecting, of course, the three constraints mentioned earlier.
